TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

As you consider the possibility of including your loved one in the Cedar Lake Family Home Provider Program, we understand that ensuring their safety and well-being is your top priority. We want to assure you that our Family Home Providers undergo rigorous training and screening to provide the highest standard of care for your loved one.

Here's a comprehensive overview of the training requirements our Family Home Providers complete:

College of Direct Supports Modules: Our Family Home Providers complete 71 online modules through the College of Direct Supports, ensuring they are equipped with the knowledge and skills necessary to support individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities effectively.

Crisis Prevention and Intervention Training: Safety is paramount. Providers receive training in crisis prevention and intervention techniques to effectively manage challenging situations while maintaining the dignity and well-being of those they support.

CPR / First Aid: In emergencies, every second counts. Our providers are certified in CPR and First Aid, ensuring they can respond promptly and appropriately to medical emergencies.

Bloodborne Pathogen Training: We prioritize the health and safety of both our providers and the individuals they support. Training in bloodborne pathogens ensures proper handling and disposal of potentially hazardous materials.

Incident Report Training: Transparency and accountability are key. Providers are trained to accurately document and report any incidents, ensuring timely resolution and prevention of future occurrences.

Drill Training: Preparedness is essential. Providers undergo drill training to effectively respond to various emergency scenarios, ensuring the safety and well-being of everyone in the home.

Medication Administration: Proper medication management is crucial. Our providers receive training in safe and accurate medication administration to ensure the health and well-being of those they support.



TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Drug Test and Background Check: All individuals over the age of 18 residing in the home undergo drug testing and background checks to maintain a safe and secure environment.

Home Visit: We conduct comprehensive home visits to assess safety measures such as the availability of first aid kits, appropriate water temperature, functioning smoke detectors, and the overall suitability of communal living spaces and individual bedrooms.

Ongoing Training: Ongoing education includes updated modules on best practices, advanced crisis prevention techniques, and the latest in medical and behavioral support.

At Cedar Lake, we are committed to providing a safe, nurturing, and inclusive environment for your loved one. Our rigorous training requirements and thorough screening processes ensure that our Family Home Providers are equipped to deliver exceptional care and support.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What happens if my relative needs additional services?

While our priority is for an individual to reside in their FHP long-term, we understand there can come a time when additional services are needed. Individuals who may eventually require more specialized care are eligible to access our Intermediate Care Facilities and staffed residences, forgoing what has typically been an 8-10 year waiting list.

Cedar Lake can support an individual with IDD throughout the entire spectrum of their life, bringing new meaning to continuity of care.

What Kentucky Medicaid Waivers are accepted for the FHP program?

Individuals with a Supports for Community Living (SCL) waiver may be accepted to the Family Home Provider program after evaluation of their care needs.

What additional services are available?

Individuals residing with an FHP are part of the Cedar Lake family, benefiting from our entire spectrum of services under the Supports for Community Living waiver, if deemed appropriate, which include:

- Supported Employment
- Day Training

Living with a Family Home Provider (FHP) creates the unique opportunity for your loved one to receive truly comprehensive, personalized, and consistent care. Anyone living with an FHP becomes part of a family, celebrating all of life's moments together. FHP's and the prospective individual are carefully matched to ensure a successful fit.
